

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 121 OF 2010

(Navigational Warning and Related Information)

**Salvage of Sunken Wreck to the South West of Green Island
in the Western Fairway**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that with immediate effect and for a period of approximately 3 weeks, salvage operations to remove a sunken wreck will be carried out in a water area to the south west of Green Island. The area is bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum):

- (A) Lat 22° 16.611' N Long 114 06.354' E
- (B) Lat 22° 16.860' N Long 114 06.204' E
- (C) Lat 22° 17.082' N Long 114 06.332' E
- (D) Lat 22° 16.849' N Long 114 06.535' E
- (E) Lat 22° 16.768' N Long 114 06.582' E

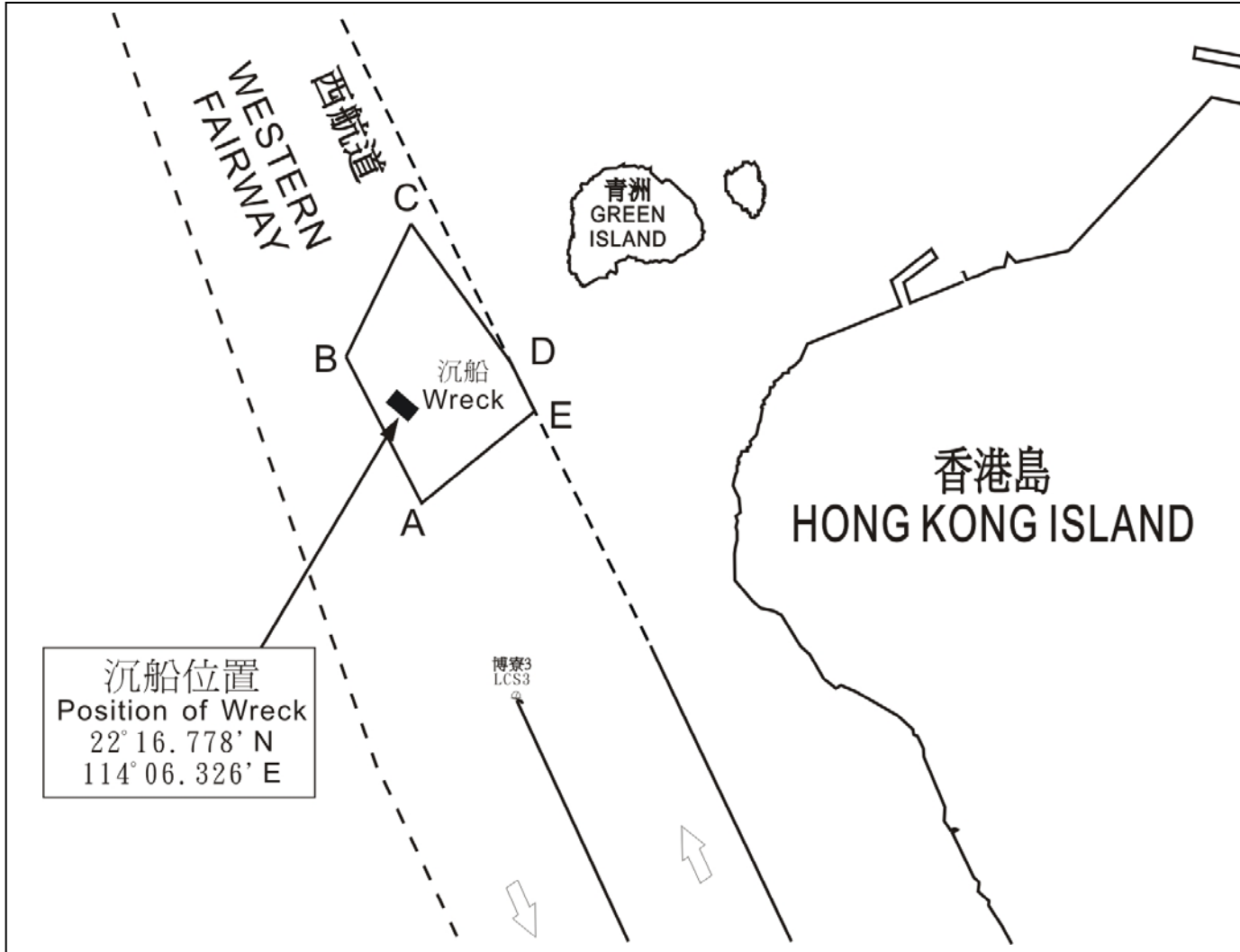
2. The works will be carried out round-the-clock from a flotilla of vessels including two crane barges, some tugs, a few work boats and guard boats. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations. The number of vessels engaged in the works will change from time to time to suit operational requirements.
3. A working area of approximately 50 metres around each of the crane barges will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the crane barges.
4. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep well clear at slow speed, bearing in mind there are divers working in the area.
5. A drawing showing the salvage works area is attached to this Notice.
