

General Information on Procurement of Government New Vessels

1 Foreword

This page serves to give general information to tenderers or visitors on procurement of Government New Vessels.

2 Role of Government New Construction (GNC) Section

GNC Section under the Government Fleet Division of the Marine Department (MD) is responsible for the procurement of new vessels for the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.

3 Tender Notice

New tender notice, if any, will be published in the Government Gazette on Friday for two consecutive weeks. Complete tender documents including specifications and other requirements will be published for free download on the MD website: <http://www.mardep.gov.hk/en/tender/home.html>.

4 Qualification of Tenderer

4.1 Experience and technical capability Tenderer must be a shipyard or company with relevant design experience and new building and project management capability of ship construction.

4.2 Financial capability Tenderer must prove the finance of the shipyard or company sound and be able to provide confidence and guarantee to the Government that contract if awarded, the successful tenderer can fulfill the obligation. Details of the securing requirements depend on the specific requirements of the individual tenderer.

4.3 Tenderer outside HKSAR must have a representative in Hong Kong to deal with the tender matters relating to the vessel during the period of construction and warranty period.

5 Tender Evaluation

After assessment of the technical capability of the tenderer and technical compliance of the essential requirements with the procurement specification, marking scheme with relative weighing of 60% for the price and 40% for the quality will be used to determine the appropriate tender offer. Final acceptance of the tender offer will be based on the financial capability of the tenderer to fulfill the contract obligation.

6 Contract Award Notice

Successful tenderer will be notified by means of a Letter of Notification of Award. Notice of the contract award will be published in the Government Gazette and made available on the Internet after contract has been signed.

7 World Trade Organization Agreement on Government Procurement

The tenders are covered by the Agreement on Government Procurement of the World Trade Organization. The Government of Hong Kong Special Administrative Region does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender or any tender, and reserves the right to negotiate with any tenderer about the terms of the offer.

8 Laws and Regulations related to Government Procurement

The government procurement process is governed by the Stores and Procurement Regulations issued by the Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury under the Public Finance Ordinance. The procedures laid down in these Regulations are fully consistent with the provisions in the WTO GPA.
