
- 1. (a) In terms of International Code of Signals, state the meaning of each of the following Procedure signals:-

 - (ii) adrift
 - (iii) disabled
 - (iv) dragging (of anchor)
 - (v) rendez-vous

5. You (the vessel with call sign VREB) are required to send the following information to another vessel but you are unable to establish a common language with her. Prepare a suitable message in International Code:

"I have stuck an unknown object. My vessel is seriously damaged. My engine room is flooded. Leak is gaining rapidly. Weather is bad. The wind is expected to become squally. I require immediate assistance; I am drifting. My present position is latitude 32 degrees 18 minutes north longitude 180 degrees 28 minutes east. I cannot maintain my present course. Can you offer vessel to stand by assistance? "
