

Points to note for a vessel carrying Class 1 dangerous goods (explosive) on board staying in the Western Dangerous Goods Anchorage (WDGA):

- (1) No Class 1 dangerous goods (explosive) shall be conveyed by vessel except written permission granted from the Director of Marine.
- (2) The owner, coxswain or person-in-charge of the vessel is recommended to notify the Marine Department before the vessel anchor or berth at WDGA, with a 24-hour emergency telephone number as well as the name of the contact person.
- (3) You are reminded that the Director of Marine has powers under the legislation to give to the owner, coxswain or person-in-charge of any vessel any directions as he thinks fit for ensuring the safety of the vessel in the waters of Hong Kong.
