HONG KONG MERCHANT SHIPPING INFORMATION NOTE

Amendments to the International Convention for Safe Containers (CSC), 1972

To : Shipowners, Ship Managers, Ship Operators, Masters, Classification Societies and Terminal Operators

Summary

The purpose of this Note is to promulgate IMO resolution MSC.355(92) and to advise the parties concerned the amendments to the International Convention for Safe Containers (CSC), 1972. The amendments will enter into force on 1 July 2014.

1. The Maritime Safety Committee (MSC) of the International Maritime Organization (IMO) adopted the resolution MSC.355(92) on 21 June 2013 to amend the International Convention for Safe Containers (CSC), 1972. The amendments will enter into force on 1 July 2014.

2. The amendments involve the following annexes of CSC:.

I	Regulations for the Testing, Inspection, Approval and Maintenance of Containers
II	Structural Safety Requirements and Tests
III	Control and Verification
