



2014 Guidelines on Survey and Certification of the Energy Efficiency Design Index (EEDI)

Summary

This Note advises that IMO has adopted the “2014 Guidelines on Survey and Certification of the Energy Efficiency Design Index (EEDI)”.

1. The Marine Environment Protection Committee (MEPC) of the International Maritime Organization at its 67th session in October 2014 has adopted, by Resolution MEPC.254(67), the “2014 Guidelines on Survey and Certification of the Energy Efficiency Design Index (EEDI)”. The Guidelines revokes the “2012 Guidelines on Survey and Certification of the Energy Efficiency Design Index (EEDI)”, adopted by resolution MEPC.214(63), as amended by resolution MEPC.234(65).
