## HONG KONG MERCHANT SHIPPING INFORMATION NOTE

**United Nations Sanctions (Yemen) Regulation 2015 (Amendment) Regulation 2016**

*To : Shipowners, Ship Managers and Masters*

***Summary***

The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) gazetted the United Nations Sanctions (Yemen) Regulation 2015 (Amendment) Regulation 2016 (L.N. 91 of 2016) ('the Amendment Regulation 2016') on 27 May 2016. The Amendment Regulation 2016, which came into effect on 27 May 2016, gives effect to certain decisions in Resolution 2266 (2016) as adopted by the Security Council of the United Nations on 24 February 2016.

1. The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region gazetted the United Nations Sanctions (Yemen) Regulation 2015 (Amendment) Regulation 2016 (L.N. 91 of 2016) on 27 May 2016 and it came into effect on the same day.
2. The 'Amendment Regulation 2016' gives effect to certain decisions in Resolution 2266 (2016) as adopted by the Security Council of the United Nations on 24 February 2016 by providing for the prohibition against :
  - (a) making available to, or for the benefit of, certain persons or entities any funds or other financial assets or economic resources;
  - (b) dealing with funds or other financial assets or economic resources belonging to, or owned or controlled by, certain persons or entities; and
  - (c) entry into or transit through the HKSAR by certain persons.
3. Sections 5A, 7A, 7B, 9A, 9B and 30A of the 'the Amendment Regulation 2016' will expire at midnight on 26 February 2017.

5. Owners, managers and masters of Hong Kong registered ships should abide by the regulation mentioned above.
