## HONG KONG MERCHANT SHIPPING INFORMATION NOTE

**United Nations Sanctions (Yemen) Regulation 2015 (Amendment) Regulation 2018**

To : *Shipowners, Ship Managers and Masters*

***Summary***

The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) gazetted the United Nations Sanctions (Yemen) Regulation 2015 (Amendment) Regulation 2018 (L.N. 118 of 2018) ('the Amendment Regulation 2018') on 8 June 2018. The Amendment Regulation 2018, which came into effect on the same day, gives effect to certain decisions in Resolution 2402 (2018) as adopted by the Security Council of the United Nations on 26 February 2018.

1. The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region gazetted the United Nations Sanctions (Yemen) Regulation 2015 (Amendment) Regulation 2018 (L.N. 118 of 2018) on 8 June 2018 and it came into effect on the same day.
2. The 'Amendment Regulation 2018' gives effect to certain decisions in Resolution 2402 (2018) as adopted by the Security Council of the United Nations on 26 February 2018 by providing for the prohibition against :
  - (a) making available to, or for the benefit of, certain persons or entities any funds or other financial assets or economic resources;
  - (b) dealing with funds or other financial assets or economic resources belonging to, or owned or controlled by, certain persons or entities; and
  - (c) entry into or transit through the HKSAR by certain persons.

4. Owners, managers and masters of Hong Kong registered ships should abide by the regulation mentioned above.
