## HONG KONG MERCHANT SHIPPING INFORMATION NOTE

## Amendments to the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea, 1974, as amended

To : Shipowners, Ship Managers, Ship Operators, Masters, Classification Societies and Shipbuilders

## Summary

The purpose of this Note is to promulgate IMO resolution MSC. 482(103) and to advise the parties concerned of the amendments to Chapter II-1 and III of the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS), 1974, as amended which will enter into force on 1 January 2024.

- 1. The Maritime Safety Committee (MSC) of the International Maritime Organization (IMO), at its 103<sup>rd</sup> session (MSC 103), adopted, inter alia, resolution MSC. 482(103) on 13 May 2021 in amending the SOLAS. The amendments will enter into force on 1 January 2024. However, for SOLAS Chapter III Regulation 33.2 as amended by MSC.482(103), circular MSC.8/Circ.2 which was approved at MSC 103 stipulated that the amended SOLAS Chapter III Regulation 33.2 may be implemented earlier on a voluntary basis prior to the entry-into-force date of 1 January 2024.
- 2. Resolution MSC.482(103) introduces amendments to Chapter II-1 and Chapter III of SOLAS as summarized below, among others: -

Resolution	Chapter/Part/Reg.	Matters of concern
MSC. 482(103)	II-1/B-4/25-1	New requirements for the installation of water level detectors on multiple hold cargo ships other than bulk carriers and tankers, for which constructed on or after 1 January 2024.
MSC. 482(103)	III/B/33.2	Amendments to clarify that only davit-launched lifeboats will be subject to the requirement of demonstrating capability of launching and towing while the ship is making headway at speeds up to 5 knots in calm water.
