## HONG KONG MERCHANT SHIPPING INFORMATION NOTE

**United Nations Sanctions (Somalia) Regulation 2019 (Amendment) Regulation 2022**

*To : Shipowners, Ship Managers, Ship Operators and Masters*

***Summary***

The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) gazetted the United Nations Sanctions (Somalia) Regulation 2019 (Amendment) Regulation 2022 (L.N. 46 of 2022) (the “Amendment Regulation”) on 14 April 2022. The Amendment Regulation, which came into operation on the same date, is to give effect to certain decisions in Resolution 2607 (2021) adopted by the Security Council of the United Nations on 15 November 2021.

1. The Amendment Regulation amends the United Nations Sanctions (Somalia) Regulation 2019 (Cap. 537CG) (principal Regulation) and came into operation on 14 April 2022.
2. The main provisions of the Amendment Regulation relate to the requirements of the licences for:-
  - (a) the supply, sale, transfer or carriage of weapons or military equipment to Somalia; and
  - (b) the provision of technical advice, financial or other assistance, or training, related to military activities.

4. Shipowners, ship managers, ship operators and masters of Hong Kong registered ships should abide by the Amendment Regulation mentioned above.
