HONG KONG MERCHANT SHIPPING INFORMATION NOTE

IMO updated Lists of Solid Bulk Cargoes for which a Fixed Gas Fire-extinguishing System may be exempted or for which a Fixed Gas Fire-extinguishing System is Ineffective

To : Shipowners, Ship Managers, Ship Operators, Ship Masters and Classification Societies

Summary

This Note draws attention to the latest *Lists of solid bulk cargoes for which a fixed gas fire-extinguishing system may be exempted or for which a fixed gas fire-extinguishing system is ineffective* approved by the International Maritime Organization (IMO) in April 2022. This Note supersedes the Hong Kong Merchant Shipping Information Note No. 23/2020 issued on 21 September 2020.

1. The Maritime Safety Committee (MSC) of the International Maritime Organization (IMO), at its 105th session, approved the *Lists of solid bulk cargoes for which a fixed gas fire-extinguishing system may be exempted or for which a fixed gas fire-extinguishing system is ineffective* on 28 April 2022 for circulation as MSC.1/Circ.1395/Rev.5 (“the Lists”).

3. Shipowners, ship managers, ship operators, ship masters and classification societies of Hong Kong registered ships are advised to note the Lists and act accordingly.
