## HONG KONG MERCHANT SHIPPING INFORMATION NOTE

## Amendments to the International Code for Ships Operating in Polar Waters (Polar Code)

To : Shipowners, Ship Managers, Ship Operators, Ship Masters, Classification Societies and Shipbuilders

## Summary

The purpose of this Note is to promulgate IMO resolution MSC.538(107) and to advise the parties concerned of the amendments to Part I-A and Part I-B of the International Code for Ships Operating in Polar Waters (Polar Code) which will enter into force on 1 January 2026.

- 1. The Maritime Safety Committee (MSC) of the International Maritime Organization (IMO) at its 107<sup>th</sup> session adopted the resolution MSC.538(107) on 8 June 2023 to amend the Polar Code to mandate navigation and voyage planning requirements for certain non-SOLAS ships operating in polar waters. The amendments will enter into force on 1 January 2026.
- 2. The amendments to Polar Code will be applicable to the following types of non-SOLAS ships on all voyages within polar waters:
  - (a) fishing vessels of 24 meters in length overall and above;
  - (b) pleasure yachts of 300 gross tonnage and upwards not engaged in trade; and
  - (c) cargo ships of 300 gross tonnage and upwards but below 500 gross tonnage.

- 4. Shipowners, ship managers, ship operators, ship masters, classification societies and shipbuilders of Hong Kong registered ships are reminded to note the above.
