

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 33 OF 2019

(Marine Works)

Establishment of Silt Curtains at North-eastern Corner of New Yau Ma Tei Typhoon Shelter

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately 16 months, silt curtains will be established within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (D) and the adjacent shoreline:

(A)	22° 18.984' N	114° 09.573' E
(B)	22° 18.979' N	114° 09.559' E
(C)	22° 18.998' N	114° 09.551' E
(D)	22° 19.010' N	114° 09.556' E

2. The silt curtains will be established near the outlet of the Cherry Street box culvert at north-eastern corner of New Yau Ma Tei Typhoon Shelter, with two ends fixed on vertical seawall, to intercept general floating refuse from the culvert.
3. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid along the surface of the silt curtains to mark the extent of the silt curtains.
4. Diving operations will be carried out from a work boat from time to time during the laying, inspection and maintenance operations.
5. Vessel engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep clear of the silt curtains at slow speed, bearing in mind there are divers working around the silt curtains.
7. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.

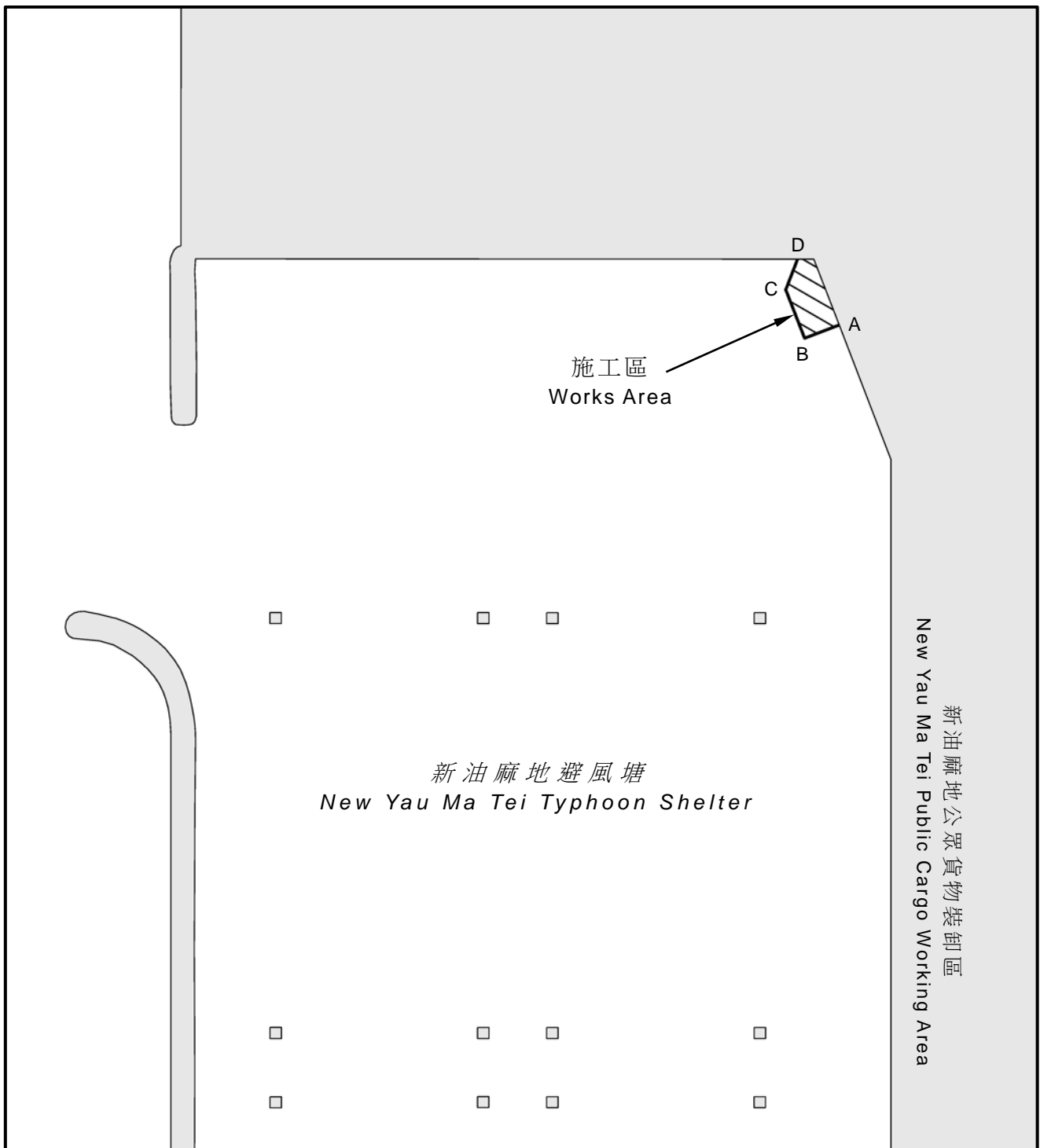
