

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 35 OF 2019

(Marine Works)

Fender Repair Works for Dolphins **in Hei Ling Chau Typhoon Shelter**

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately 4 months, fender repair works for dolphins will be carried out in Hei Ling Chau Typhoon Shelter.

2. The works will be carried out by one crane boat. One work boat will provide assistance.
3. A working area of approximately 15 metres around the crane boat will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the crane boat.
4. A silt curtain, extending from the sea surface to the seabed, will be established around the dolphins for repair. Yellow flashing lights will be laid along the surface of the silt curtain to mark the extent of the silt curtain.
5. The works will be carried out from 0800 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. Vessels engaged in the works will stay close to the dolphins outside the hours of work.
6. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time during the hours of work.
7. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.

8. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution, bearing in mind there are divers working around the dolphins.

9. A drawing showing the locations of the dolphins involved in the works is attached to this Notice.

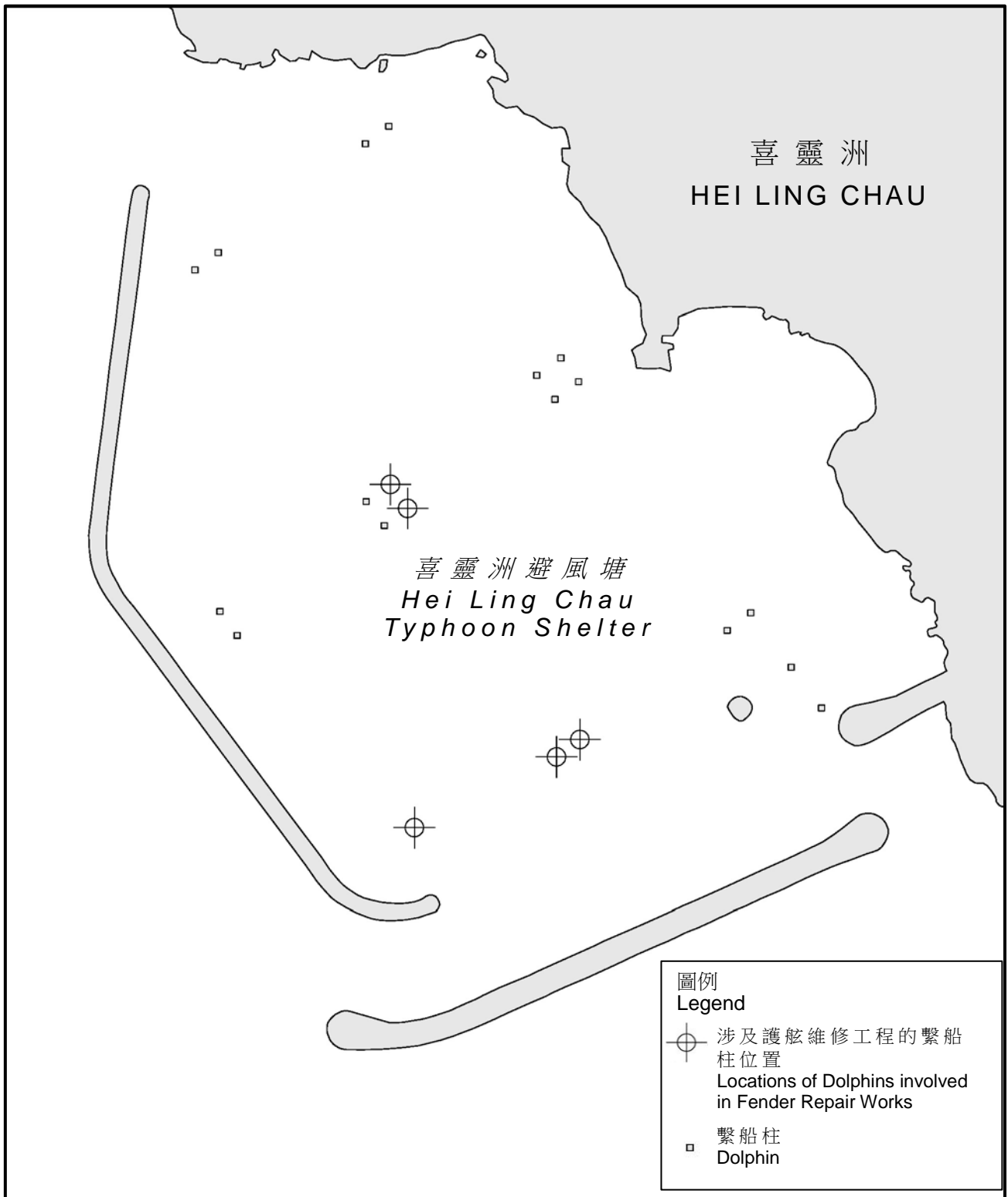
