(Statutory Requirements)

<u>Implementation of the Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution by</u> <u>Garbage) (Amendment) (No.2) Regulation 2019</u>

This Notice informs the shipping industry that the Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution by Garbage) (Amendment) (No.2) Regulation 2019 (the "Amendment Regulation") for incorporating the latest requirements of the Annex V to the International Convention for the Prevention of Pollution from Ships ("MARPOL") adopted by the International Maritime Organization under Resolution MEPC.277(70) has entered into force on 1 January 2020. - 2. The Amendment Regulation amends the Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution by Garbage) Regulation (Cap. 413O), which requires:-
 - (a) the classification of harmful substances to the marine environment as specified in Annex V to MARPOL shall be complied with; and
 - (b) a ship which is:
 - (i) of 400 GT or above and is certified to carry less than 15 persons;
 - (ii) of 400 GT or above, certified to carry 15 or more persons and engaged in a voyage of more than one hour in duration; or
 - (iii) certified to carry 15 or more persons and engaged in an international voyage of more than one hour;

to use new form of Garbage Record Book ("GRB") to record the handling of shipboard garbage in line with the latest Annex V to MARPOL requirements. The new form of GRB is given in the Appendix to this Notice for reference purpose.
