

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 4/2021

(Marine Works)

**Reclamation to the Southwest of Shek Kwu Chau
for the Integrated Waste Management Facilities**

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately 12 months, reclamation works involving sand filling, hydrographic survey, and construction of seawall and breakwater will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (I) and the adjacent shoreline:

(A)	22° 11.334'N	113° 59.462'E
(B)	22° 11.149'N	113° 59.466'E
(C)	22° 11.144'N	113° 59.289'E
(D)	22° 11.237'N	113° 58.828'E
(E)	22° 11.373'N	113° 58.744'E
(F)	22° 11.491'N	113° 58.709'E
(G)	22° 11.596'N	113° 58.764'E
(H)	22° 11.656'N	113° 58.821'E
(I)	22° 11.656'N	113° 58.942'E

2. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights, radar reflectors and AIS will be laid at co-ordinates from (B) to (H) to mark the boundary of the works area.

3. The works will be carried out by a flotilla of vessels including flat top barges, derrick lighters, and special purpose vessels at various stages. Some tugboats, guard boats and self-propelled delivery barges will provide assistance. The number of vessels engaged in the works will change from time to time to suit operational requirements.

4. A working area of approximately 50 metres around each working vessel will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing

lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the working vessels.

5. Silt curtains, extending from the sea surface to the seabed, will be established within the works area. The silt curtain is a large piece of netting used to contain mud and sediments. Yellow markers fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the extent of the silt curtains.

6. The hours of work will be round-the-clock.

7. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time during the hours of work.

8. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.

9. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep clear of the works area at slow speed, bearing in mind there are divers working in the works area.

10. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.

11. This Notice should be read in conjunction with Marine Department Notice No. 3/2021.

12. This Notice supersedes Marine Department Notice No. 20/2020.

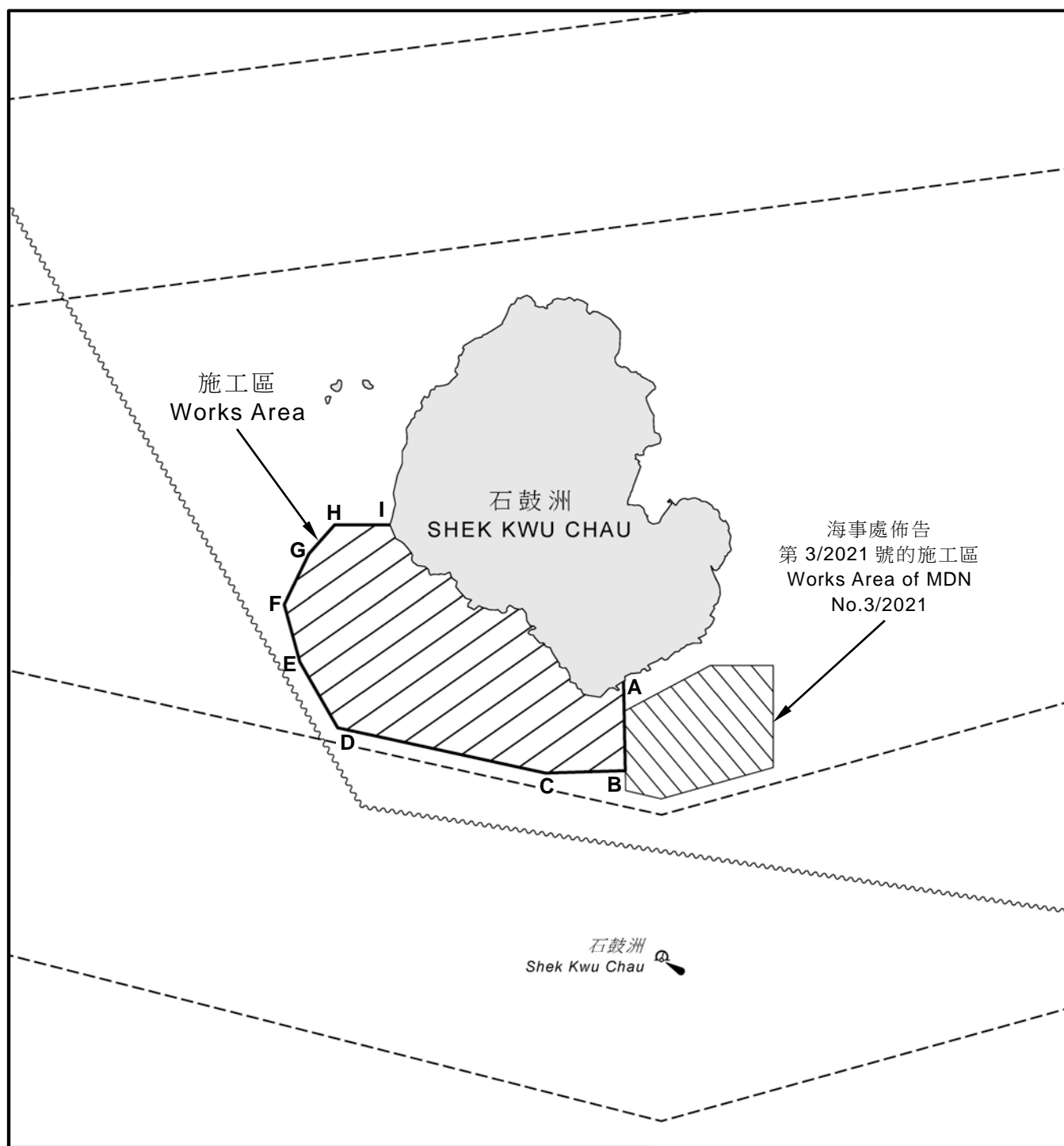
