

**MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 27/2021**

(Marine Works)

**Breakwater Reinstatement Works at Aberdeen South Typhoon Shelter**

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately 6 months, breakwater reinstatement works will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (D) and the adjacent shorelines:

(A) 22° 14.210'N 114° 09.632'E

(B) 22° 14.217'N 114° 09.812'E

(C) 22° 14.152'N 114° 09.815'E

(D) 22° 14.144'N 114° 09.616'E

2. The works will be carried out by one dumb lighter. One tugboat will provide assistance.
3. A working area of approximately 15 metres around the lighter will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the lighter.
4. A silt curtain, extending from the sea surface to the seabed, will be established within the works area. The silt curtain is a large piece of netting used to contain mud and sediments. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the extent of the silt curtain.
5. The hours of work will be from 0700 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. Vessels employed for the works will stay in the works areas outside the hours of work.
6. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
7. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.
8. A drawing showing the works areas is attached to this Notice.

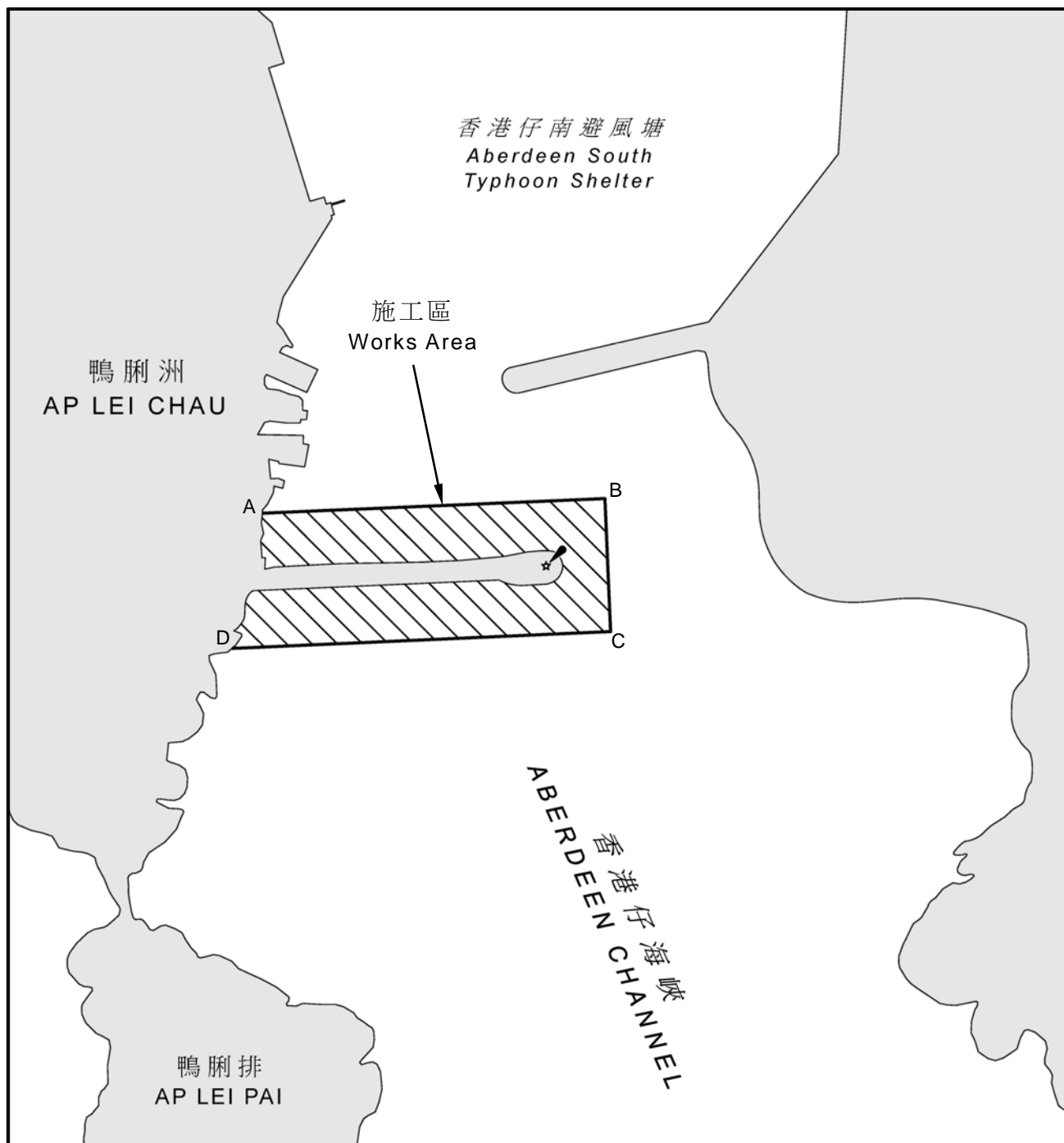
