

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 51/2021

(Marine Works)

Marine Site Investigation off West Coast of Lamma Island

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately two months, marine site investigation works involving drilling of boreholes will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (D):

(A)	22° 13.178' N	114° 04.846' E
(B)	22° 12.294' N	114° 05.062' E
(C)	22° 12.289' N	114° 04.055' E
(D)	22° 13.178' N	114° 04.475' E

2. The works will be carried out by one flat-top work barge and one work boat. One tugboat will provide assistance.
3. A working area of approximately 50 metres around the barge will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the barge.
4. The hours of work will be from 0800 to 1800 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. Vessels employed for the works will stay in the works area outside the hours of work.
5. Vessels engaged in the operations will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.
7. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.
8. This Notice should be read in conjunction with Marine Department Notices No. 32/2021, 40/2021 and 46/2021.

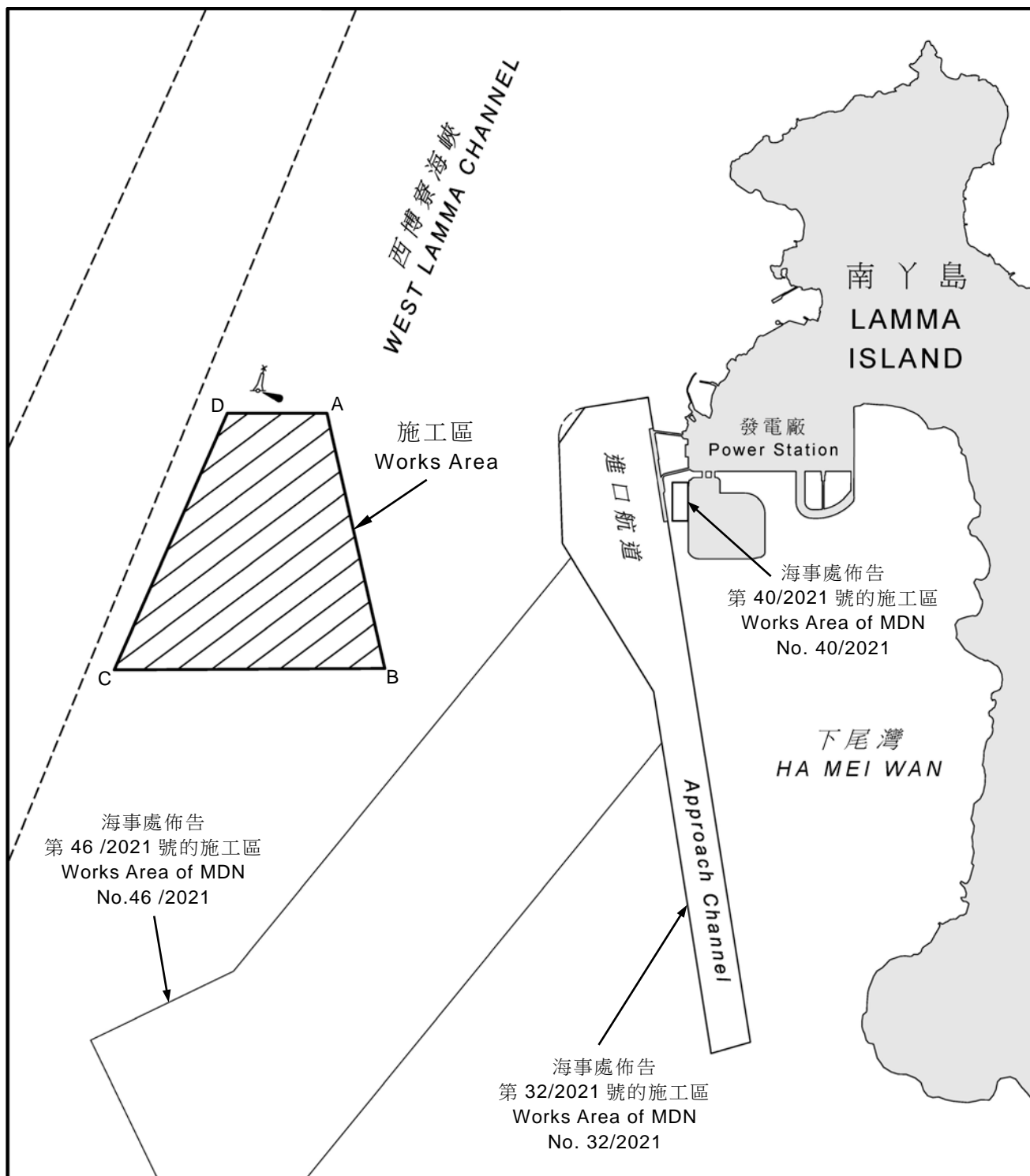
