

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 179/2021

(Marine Works)

Construction of Subsea Pipeline from West of Urmston Road Anchorage to West of Hong Kong International Airport

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately five months, construction of subsea pipeline will be carried out along the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (I):

(A)	22° 24.879'N	113° 52.579'E
(B)	22° 24.654'N	113° 52.395'E
(C)	22° 24.392'N	113° 52.280'E
(D)	22° 24.111'N	113° 52.242'E
(E)	22° 21.480'N	113° 52.257'E
(F)	22° 20.161'N	113° 52.226'E
(G)	22° 19.953'N	113° 52.206'E
(H)	22° 19.749'N	113° 52.159'E
(I)	22° 18.516'N	113° 51.779'E

2. The works will be carried out by two special purpose vessels and one dumb lighter. Four tugboats, one flat top barge and two guard boats will provide assistance.

3. A working area of approximately 50 metres around each special purpose vessel and the dumb lighter will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights and radar reflectors will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the working vessels.

4. The hours of work will be round-the-clock.

5. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time during the hours of work.

6. Vessels engaged in the operation will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
7. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep clear of the works area at slow speed, bearing in mind there are divers working in the area.
8. A drawing showing the alignment of the subsea pipeline is attached to this Notice.

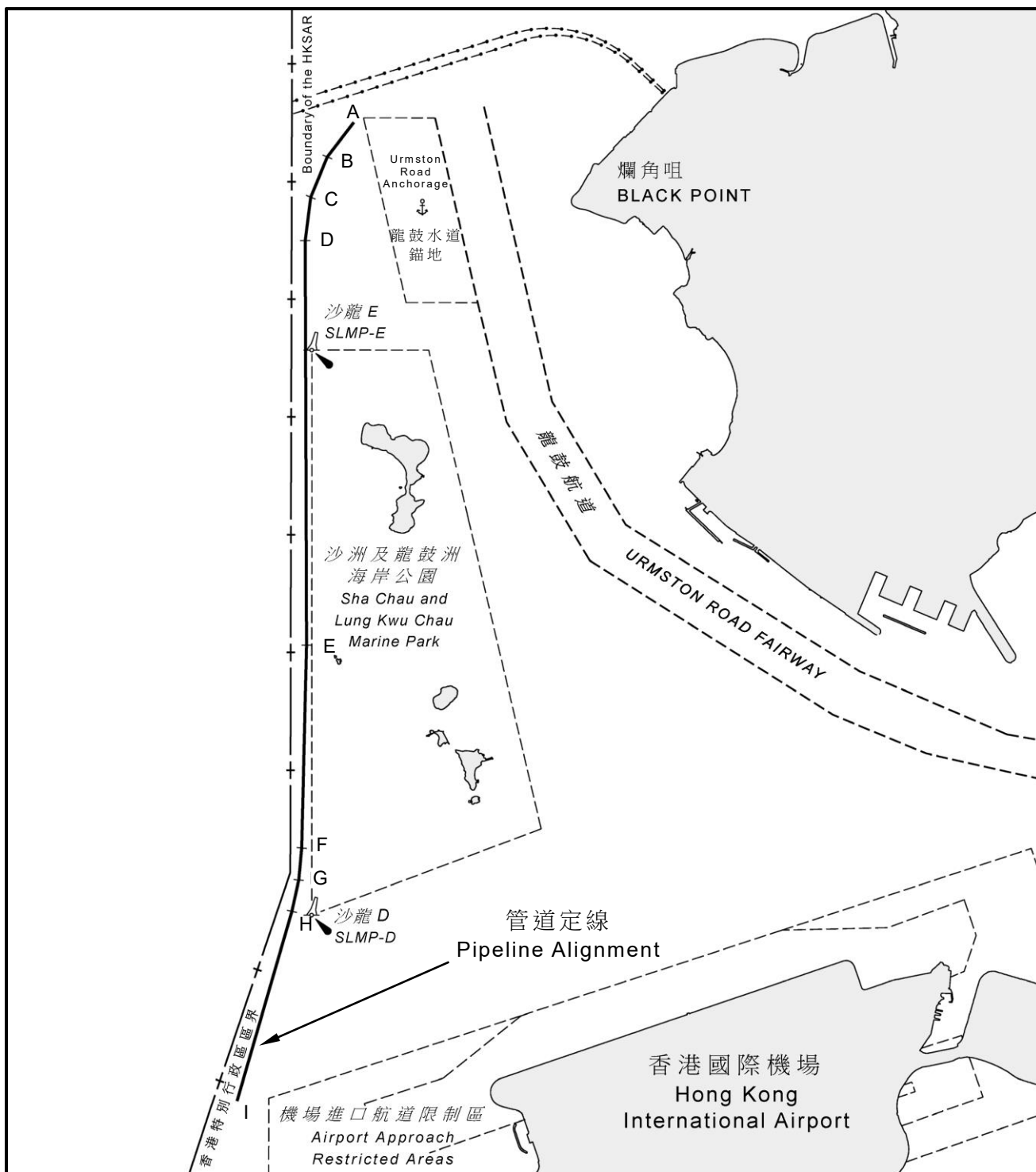
