<u>Implementation of Amendments to the IMDG Code by the Merchant Shipping (Local Vessels) (General) (Amendment) Regulation 2022</u>

The Merchant Shipping (Local Vessels) (General) (Amendment) Regulation 2022 (the "Amendment Regulation") will come into operation on 1 November 2022 to implement the amendments to the International Maritime Dangerous Goods Code (IMDG Code) as stipulated in resolution MSC.477(102) adopted by the International Maritime Organization. - 2. The following amendments made by the Amendment Regulation are applicable to local vessels engaged in maritime transport of dangerous goods:
 - (a) amendments to and updates of some definitions;
 - (b) various amendments to classification chapters such as introducing criteria;
 - (c) several changes to segregation groups, instructions and provisions; and
 - (d) updates of packaging, marking and labelling of dangerous goods.
