

**Annual Report on the Performance of Recognized Organizations
and Recognized Security Organizations**

Introduction

1. The autonomous Hong Kong Register of Shipping (HKSR) was established on 3 December 1990 under the Hong Kong Merchant Shipping (Registration) Ordinance. All statutory survey and certification works were delegated to Recognized Organizations (ROs) and Recognized Security Organizations (RSOs). During the reporting period from 1 January to 31 December 2021, nine Classification Societies, namely ABS, BV, CCS, DNV GL, KR, LR, NK, RINA and RS, were authorized by the Hong Kong Marine Department (HKMD) to be ROs and RSOs under the agreements made between HKMD and each of these Classification Societies.

2. The Flag State Quality Control (FSQC) System was established on 1 April 1999 to monitor the quality and performance of ships, ship management companies and the ROs. The industry responded positively to the establishment of the FSQC System, and agreed that a report should be published annually on the performance of ROs during the year.

3. This is the twenty-third report after the implementation of the FSQC System. It covers the factual data collected between 1 January 2021 and 31 December 2021 for 2,527 ocean going vessels registered with the HKSR.

Reporting Area

4. The report covers the following principal areas identified in the Agreements between the ROs and HKMD:

- i) supply of documentation;
- ii) access to information;
- iii) notification to Director;
- iv) compliance with instructions; and
- v) effectiveness of statutory survey and audits.

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The following table shows the degree of compliance of the 9 ROs collectively in respect of the 5 principal areas listed under paragraph 4 above:
