## Standard Clauses For Crew Agreement For Hong Kong Registered/Foreign Sea-Going Ship

## 18. Repatriation

- 18.1 A seafarer discharged for any reason, at a port abroad, shall be accommodated ashore when necessary and where it is not intended that he should rejoin his ship, shall be repatriated via sea or returned as soon as practicable by air or otherwise as may be directed by the ship's master and/or his accredited agent, to the place at which he was employed to join the ship.by any other appropriate and expeditious means that is agreed between the seafarer and the employer of the seafarer, to the following repatriation destination: -
  - (a) in the case of a seafarer who is resident in Hong Kong, to Hong Kong;
  - (b) in the case of a seafarer who is not resident in Hong Kong, to a place in the country in which he is resident being -
    - (i) if he joined the ship in that country, the place where he joined the ship; or
    - (ii) if he did not join the ship in that country, the place in that country at which he was employed to join the ship; or
  - (c) to any other place which may be agreed between the seafarer and his employer.
