

Marine Department and Hong Kong Shipowners Association host “2025 Joint Luncheon cum Award Presentation Ceremony”

The Marine Department (MD) and the Hong Kong Shipowners Association (HKSOA) jointly hosted the “2025 Joint Luncheon cum Award Presentation Ceremony” today (August 29). The event was organised to express appreciation for the support of shipowners and shipping companies and to promote the services of the Hong Kong Shipping Registry (HKSR) and HKSOA. The Secretary for Transport and Logistics, Ms Mable Chan, officiated and delivered a keynote speech at the event.

Today’s luncheon was one of the major annual events in the maritime industry in Hong Kong. Approximately 200 representatives from the maritime sector and distinguished guests attended the event.

Ms Mable Chan; the Acting Director of Marine, Ms Lydia Lam; Chairman of HKSOA, Mr. Angad Banga, and other government officials presented a list of awards to winning shipping companies in recognition of their outstanding performances in the pursuit of high quality Hong Kong-registered ships, their achievement of attaining high ratings under the international standards on decarbonisation formulated by the International Maritime Organization (IMO), the bravery of the masters and crew on the high seas and shipping companies’ support in nurturing young maritime talents in Hong Kong over the past year.

It is worth noting that this year marks the 35th anniversary of the establishment of HKSR. To commemorate this milestone, a special award recognising longstanding partnership was presented to honour companies that have consistently supported Hong Kong Flag since its inception.

In addition, this year, Hong Kong-registered ships received IMO’s commendations for the first time in recognition of their exceptional bravery in rescuing seafarers and mixed migrants at sea. During the luncheon, Ms Mable Chan, representing the Hong Kong flag administration, presented these commendations to the two award-winning companies. This annual IMO award, established in 2007, recognises crew who perform acts of exceptional bravery at the risk of losing their own life, displaying outstanding courage in attempting to save lives at sea or to prevent or mitigate damage to the marine environment.
