

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 55/2024

(Marine Works)

Marine Site Investigation to the West of Tsing Yi

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately nine months, marine site investigation works involving sampling of subsea soil, drilling of vibrocores, boreholes and cone penetration tests will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (E) and the adjacent shoreline:

(A)	22° 21.064'N	114° 04.935'E
(B)	22° 20.871'N	114° 04.911'E
(C)	22° 20.842'N	114° 04.799'E
(D)	22° 21.080'N	114° 04.707'E
(E)	22° 21.121'N	114° 04.854'E

2. The works will be carried out by two flat-top barges and two jack-up barges. One tugboat and one work boat will provide assistance. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
3. A working area of approximately 50 metres around each barge will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from each flat-top barge. Yellow flashing lights will be installed at the four corners of each jack-up barge to indicate its position.
4. The hours of work will be from 0700 to 2300 hours daily. Vessels employed for the works will stay in the works area outside the hours of work.
5. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.

6. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.

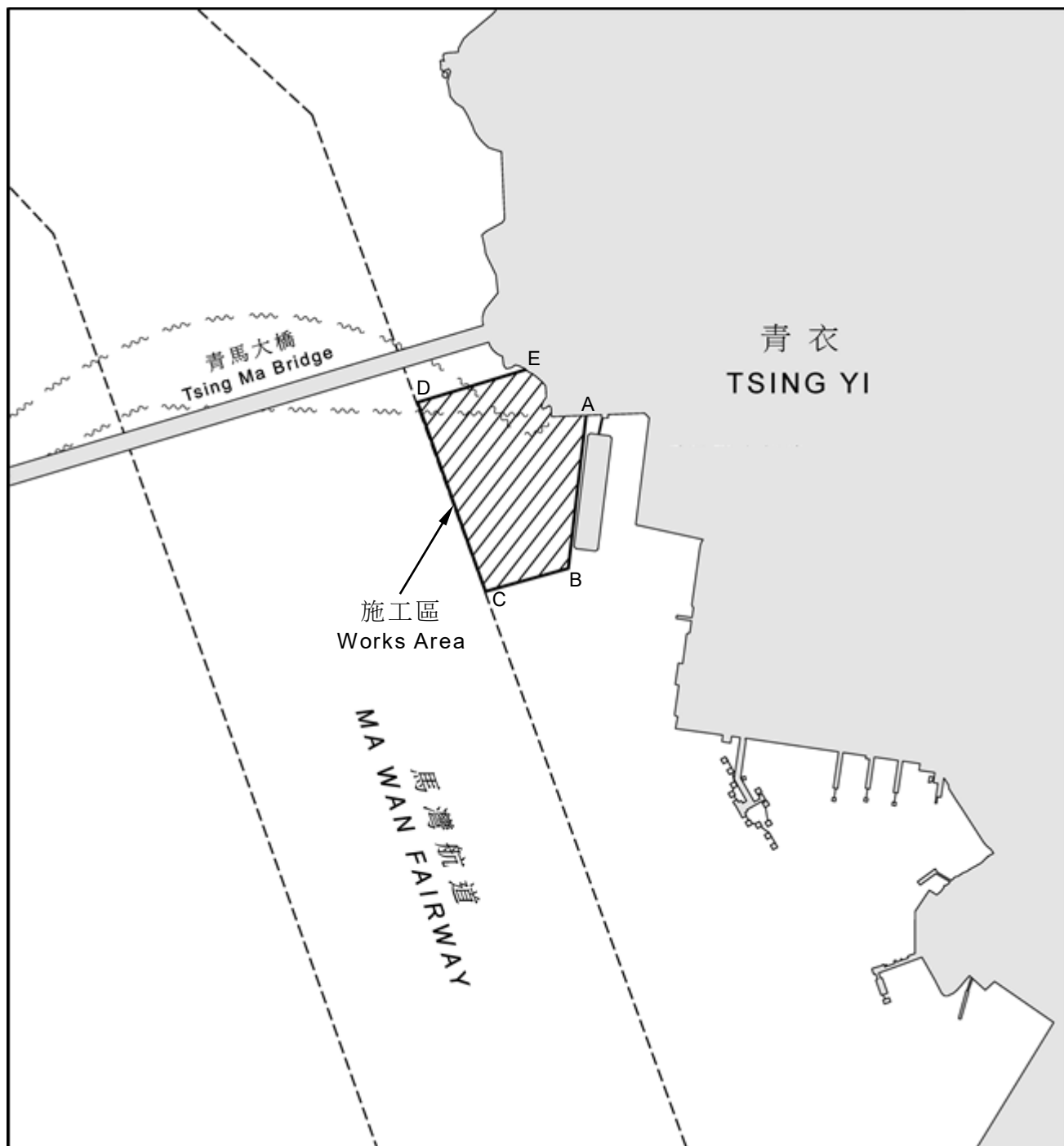
