

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 229/2025

(Marine Works)

Establishment of Silt Curtains along both sides of the Outer Breakwater at Aberdeen South Typhoon Shelter

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately nine months, marine works involving the establishment of silt curtains will be carried out in the following works areas:

Works Area 1: This area is bounded by straight lines joining the following coordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (D) and the adjacent shoreline:

(A)	22° 14.185'N	114° 09.666'E
(B)	22° 14.196'N	114° 09.666'E
(C)	22° 14.200'N	114° 09.759'E
(D)	22° 14.189'N	114° 09.759'E

Works Area 2: This area is bounded by straight lines joining the following coordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (E) to (H) and the adjacent shoreline:

(E)	22° 14.176'N	114° 09.760'E
(F)	22° 14.166'N	114° 09.760'E
(G)	22° 14.162'N	114° 09.667'E
(H)	22° 14.174'N	114° 09.667'E

2. Silt curtains are large pieces of netting to contain mud and sediments extending from the sea surface to the seabed. Yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the extent of the silt curtains upon completion.

3. The works will be carried out by one work boat. Vessel engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.

4. A working area of approximately 20 metres around the work boat will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the work boat.

5. The hours of work will be from 0700 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. Vessel employed for the works will not stay in the works areas outside the hours of work.
6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.
7. A drawing showing the works areas is attached to this Notice.

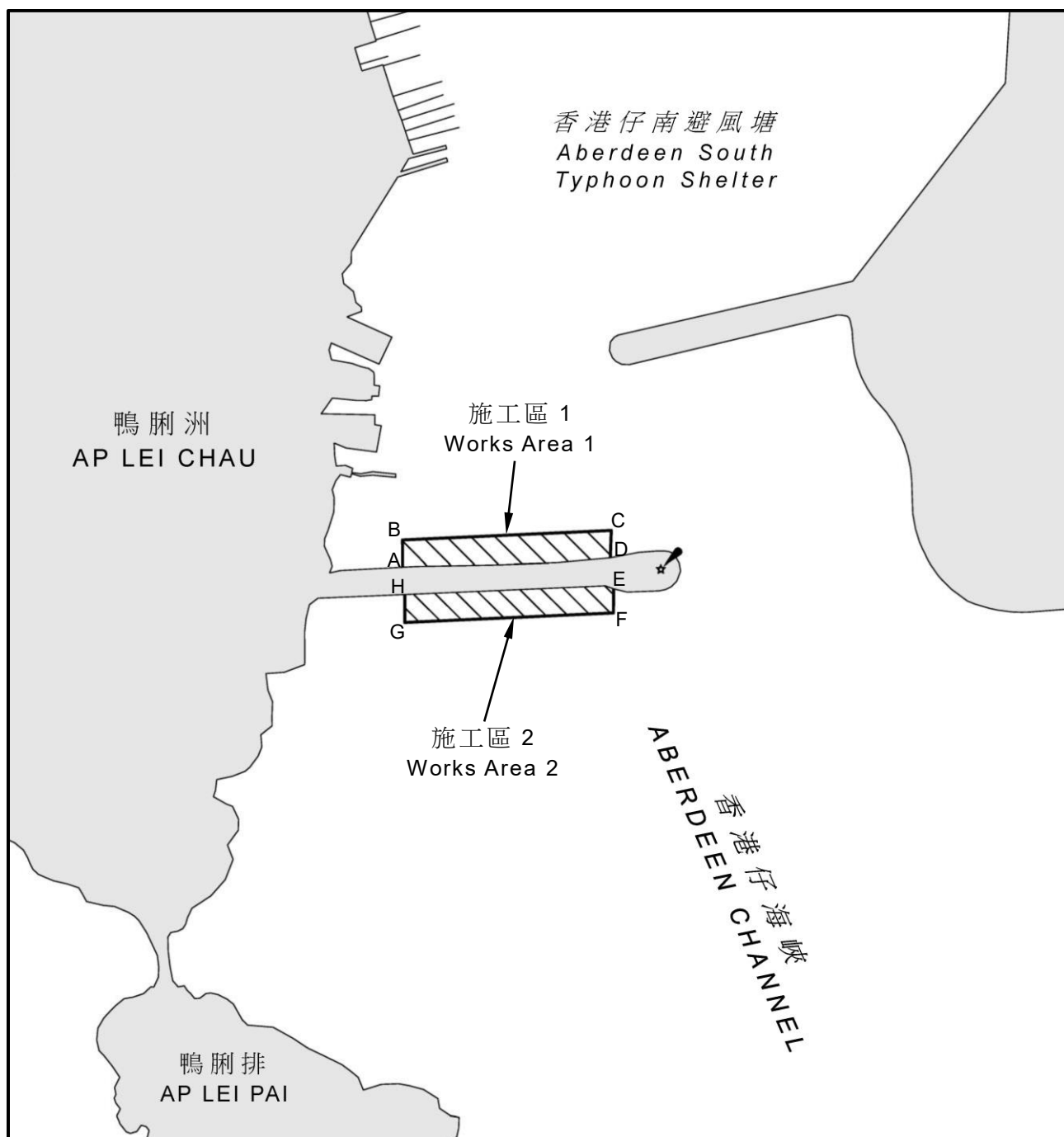
