

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 260/2025

(Marine Works)

Marine Works at the Castle Peak Power Station, Tap Shek Kok

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately nine months, marine works involving dredging operations and fender piles repair works will be carried out within the following works areas:

Works Area 1: This area is bounded by straight lines joining the following coordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (D) and the adjacent shoreline:

(A)	22° 22.395'N	113° 54.991'E
(B)	22° 22.363'N	113° 55.025'E
(C)	22° 22.259'N	113° 55.188'E
(D)	22° 22.168'N	113° 55.141'E

Works Area 2: This area is bounded by straight lines joining the following coordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (E) to (J) and the adjacent shoreline:

(E)	22° 22.158'N	113° 55.131'E
(F)	22° 22.113'N	113° 55.097'E
(G)	22° 22.196'N	113° 54.974'E
(H)	22° 22.389'N	113° 54.729'E
(I)	22° 22.451'N	113° 54.843'E
(J)	22° 22.362'N	113° 54.902'E

Works Area 3: This area is bounded by straight lines joining the following coordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (K) to (N) and the adjacent shoreline:

(K)	22° 22.421'N	113° 55.004'E
(L)	22° 22.398'N	113° 54.961'E
(M)	22° 22.427'N	113° 54.929'E
(N)	22° 22.459'N	113° 54.962'E

2. The works will be carried out by one grab dredger and one dumb lighter. Three tugboats, three work boats and two hopper barges will provide assistance. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.

3 The hours of work will be round-the-clock. A working area of approximately 50 metres around the working vessels will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the working vessels.

4. Silt curtains, which are large pieces of netting to contain mud and sediments extending from the sea surface to the seabed, will be established within the works areas. Yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the extent of the silt curtains.

5. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time during the hours of work. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep clear of the works areas at slow speed, bearing in mind that there are divers working in the areas.

6. A drawing showing the works areas is attached to this Notice. This Notice supersedes Marine Department Notice No. 2/2024.

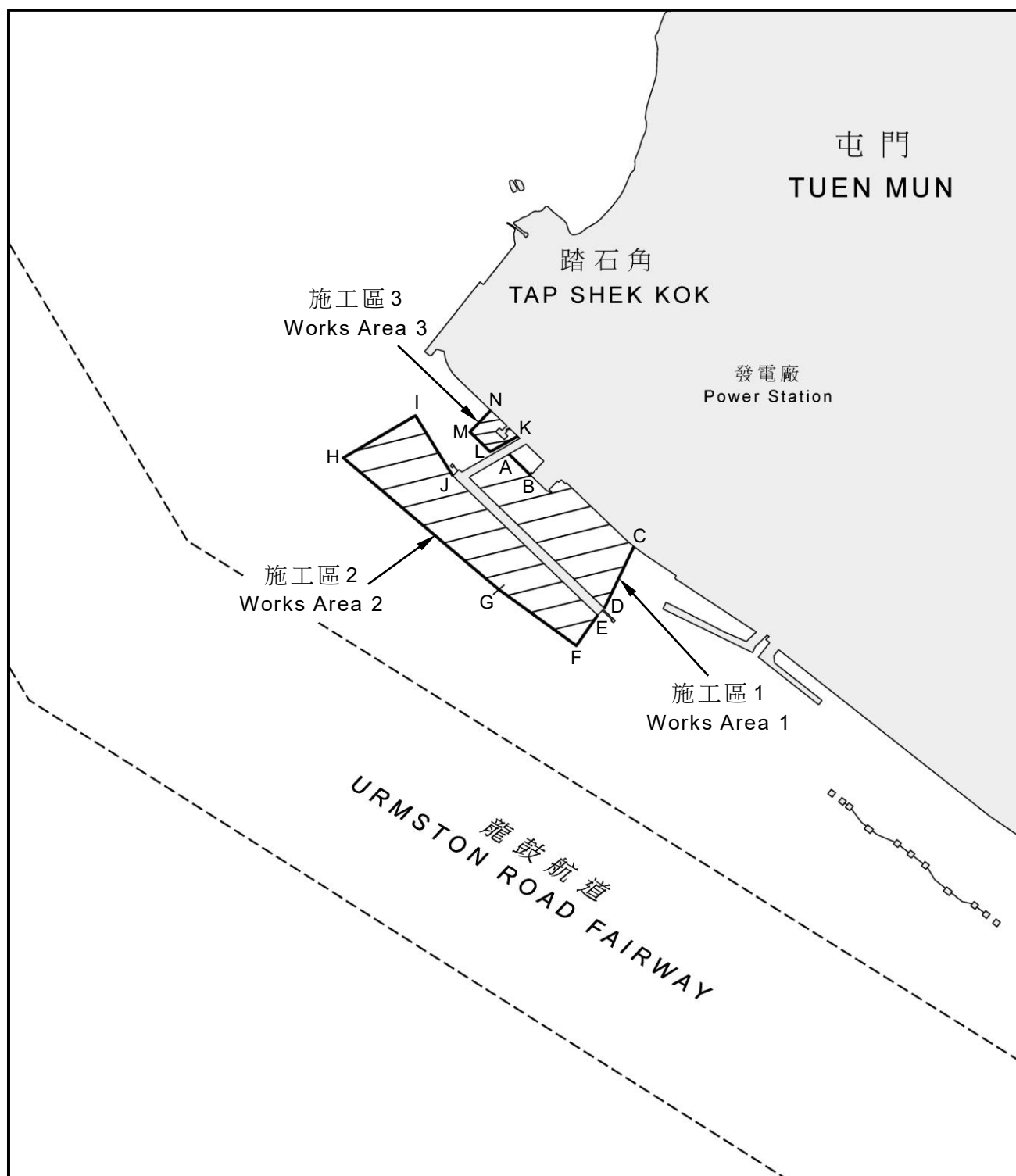
