

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 60/2026

(Marine Works)

Demolition and Disposal of Coal Ship Unloaders
at Castle Peak Power Station, Tap Shek Kok

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately one month, demolition and disposal of coal ship unloaders will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (E) and the adjacent jetty:

(A)	22° 22.215'N	113° 55.067'E
(B)	22° 22.047'N	113° 54.893'E
(C)	22° 22.245'N	113° 54.572'E
(D)	22° 22.459'N	113° 54.794'E
(E)	22° 22.362'N	113° 54.902'E

2. The works will be carried out by one crane barge and one dry cargo vessel. One anchor boat, two tugboats and three guard boats will provide assistance. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
3. A working area of approximately 150 metres around the crane barge will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights and radar reflectors will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the working vessels.
4. The hours of work will be round-the-clock. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.
5. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.

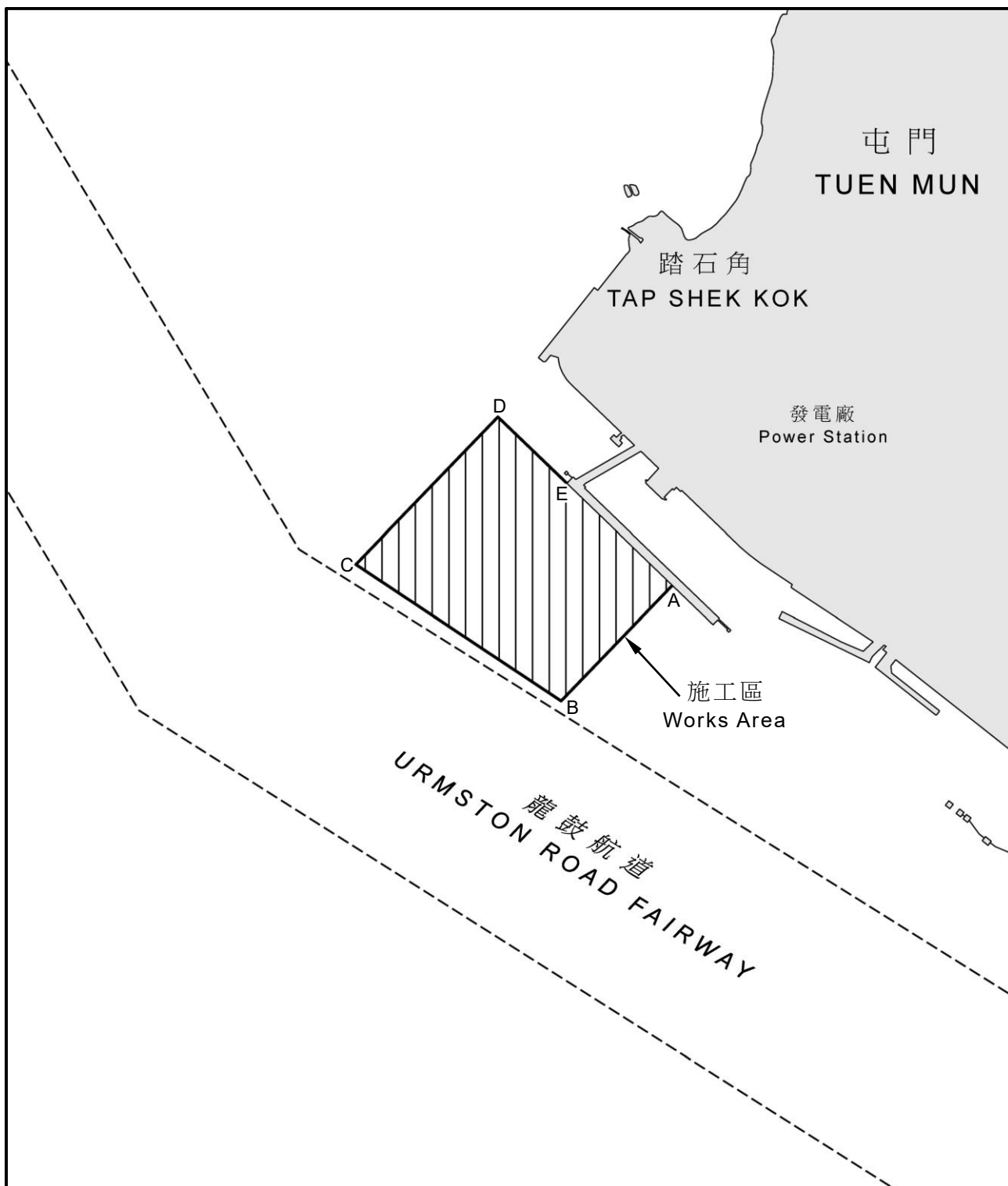
