

**MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 61/2026**

(Marine Works)

**Marine Site Investigation at Deep Bay**

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately 10 months, marine site investigation works involving drilling of boreholes will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (E):

(A) 22° 27.929'N 113° 58.821'E

(B) 22° 28.006'N 113° 58.709'E

(C) 22° 28.951'N 113° 57.632'E

(D) 22° 29.104'N 113° 57.823'E

(E) 22° 28.134'N 113° 58.904'E

2. The works will be carried out by four jack-up barges. One tugboat and one work boat will provide assistance. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.

3. A working area of approximately 15 metres around each jack-up barge will be established. Yellow flashing lights will be installed at the four corners of each jack-up barge to indicate its position.

4. The hours of work will be from 0800 to 1800 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. Vessels employed for the works will stay in the works area outside the hours of work.

5. Silt curtains, which are large pieces of netting to contain mud and sediments extending from the sea surface to the seabed, will be established at the works locations. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the extent of the silt curtains.

6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.

7. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice. This Notice supersedes Marine Department Notice No. 38/2026.

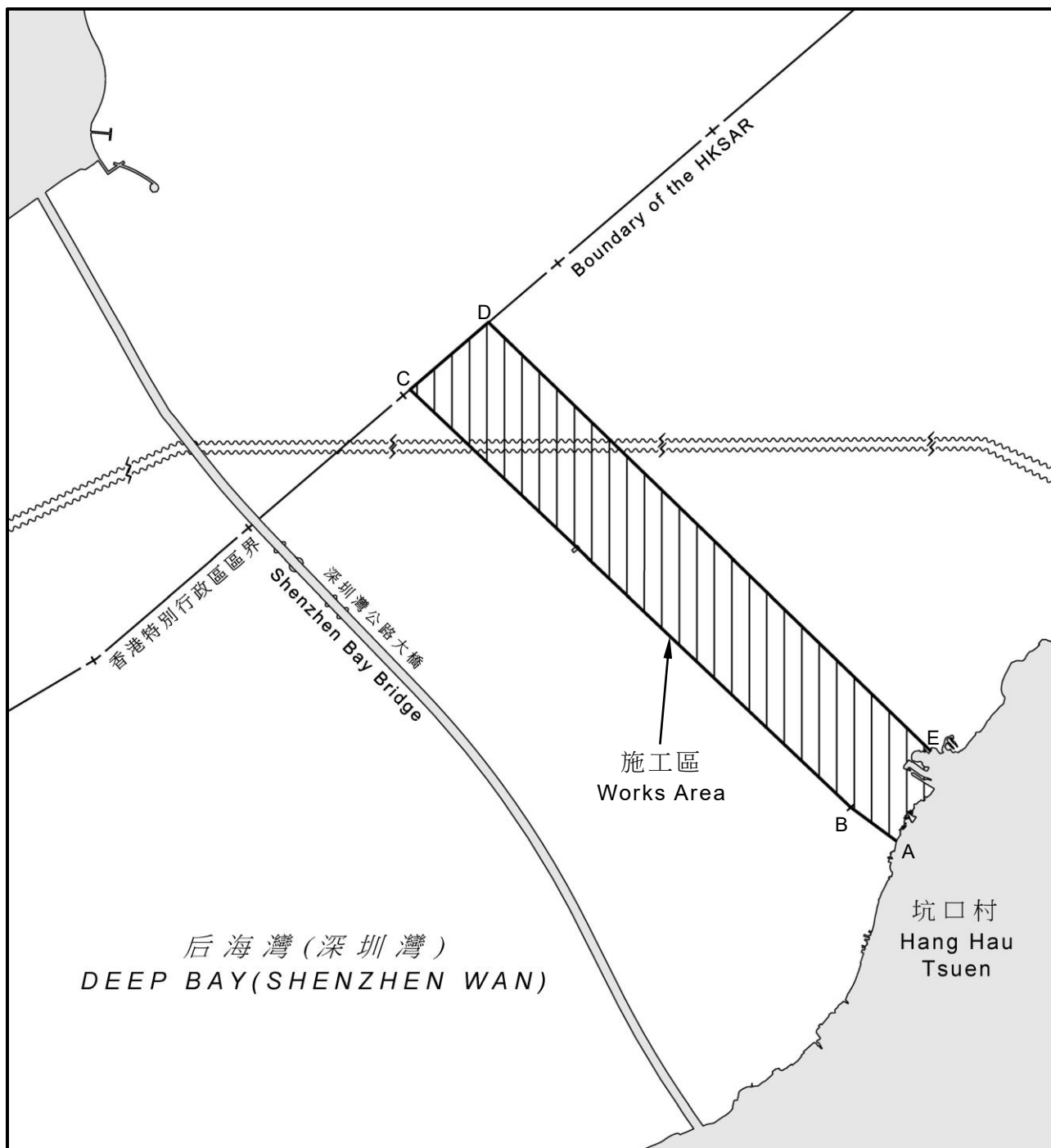
