

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 95/2026

(Marine Works)

Marine Works at Junk Bay

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately six months, marine works involving establishment of silt curtain and installation of stoplogs will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (D) and the adjacent shoreline:

(A)	22° 17.332'N	114° 16.223'E
(B)	22° 17.341'N	114° 16.208'E
(C)	22° 17.364'N	114° 16.223'E
(D)	22° 17.355'N	114° 16.238'E

2. The works will be carried out by one work boat. Vessel engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
3. A working area of approximately 10 metres around the work boat will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the work boat.
4. The hours of work will be from 0830 to 1700 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. Vessel employed for the works will not stay in the works area outside the hours of work.
5. A silt curtain which is large piece of netting to contain mud and sediments extending from the sea surface to the seabed will be established within the works area. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the extent of the silt curtain.
6. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time during the hours of work. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep clear of the works area at slow speed, bearing in mind that there are diving operations in the area.

7. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.

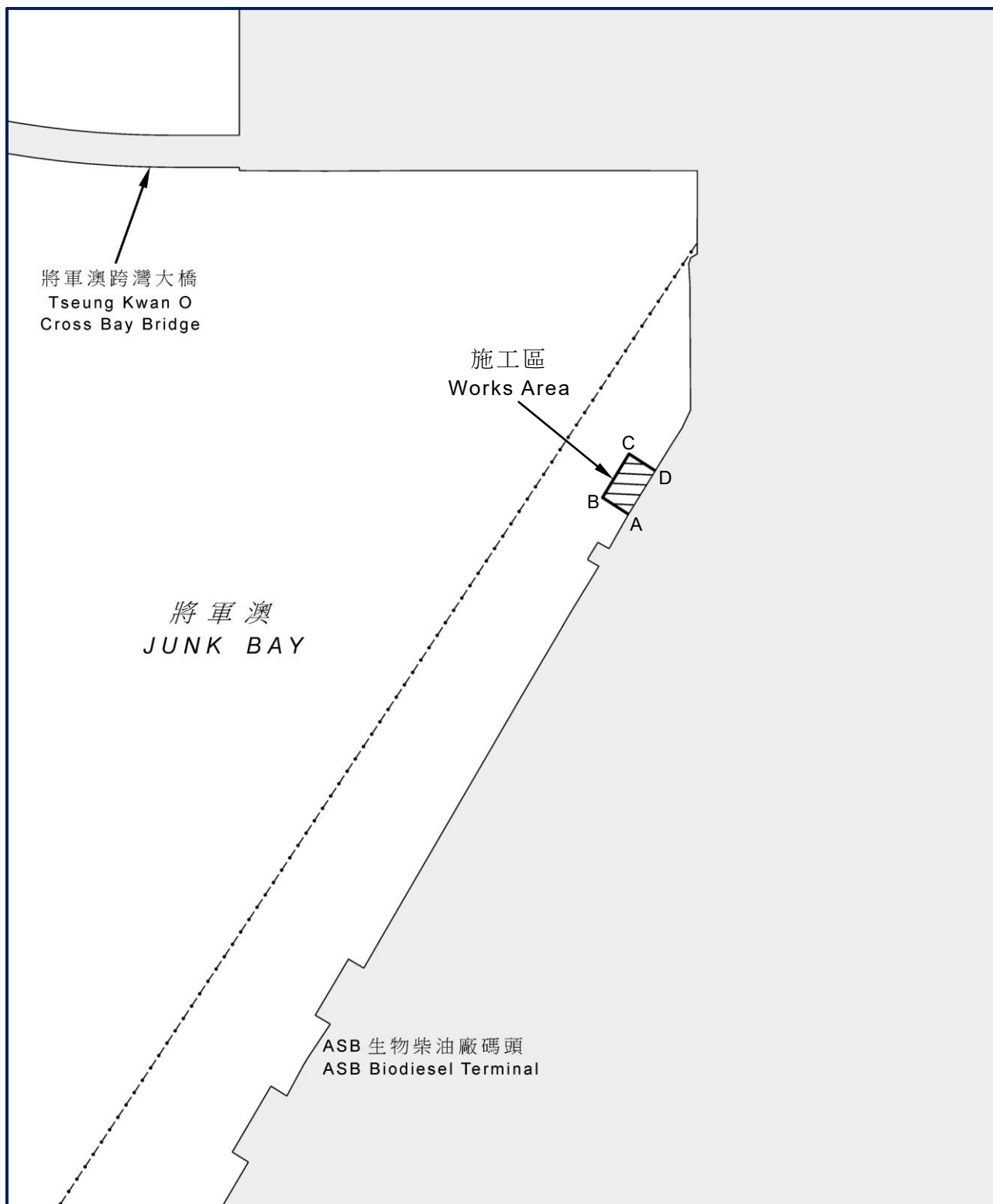
