

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 133/2026

(Marine Works)

Repair Works for Dolphins in To Kwa Wan Typhoon Shelter

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately five months, repair works for dolphins will be carried out in To Kwa Wan Typhoon Shelter.

2. The works will be carried out by one crane boat. The boat engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
3. A working area of approximately 20 metres around the boat will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the boat.
4. The hours of work will be from 0700 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. The boat employed for the works will not stay in the works area outside the hours of work.
5. A silt curtain, extending from the sea surface to the seabed, will be established around the dolphins for repair. Yellow flashing lights will be laid along the surface of the silt curtain to mark the extent of the silt curtain.
6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.
7. A drawing showing the locations of the dolphins is attached to this Notice.

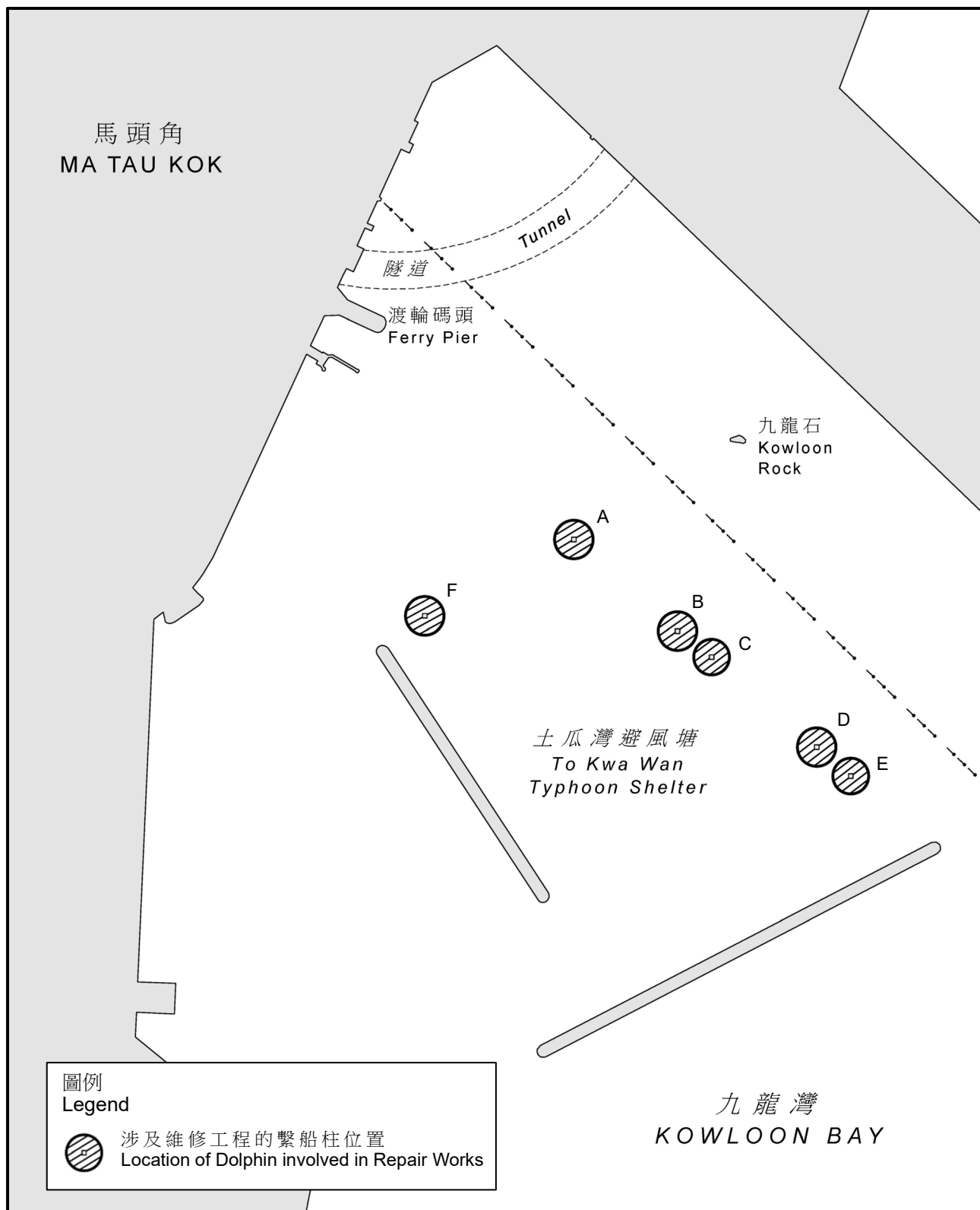
