

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 138/2026

(Marine Works)

Establishment of Silt Curtain in Deep Water Bay

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately 12 months, marine works involving the establishment of a silt curtain will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (D) and the adjacent shoreline:

(A)	22° 14.162'N	114° 11.417'E
(B)	22° 14.156'N	114° 11.380'E
(C)	22° 14.187'N	114° 11.353'E
(D)	22° 14.185'N	114° 11.377'E

2. Silt curtain is a large piece of netting to contain mud and sediments extending from the sea surface to the seabed. Yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the extent of the silt curtain upon completion.

3. The works will be carried out by one dumb lighter. One tugboat and one work boat will provide assistance. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.

4. A working area of approximately 20 metres around the lighter will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the lighter.

5. The hours of work will be from 0800 to 1800 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. Vessels employed for the works will stay in the works area outside the hours of work.

6. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time during the hours of work. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep clear of the works area at slow speed, bearing in mind that there are diving operations in the area.

7. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.

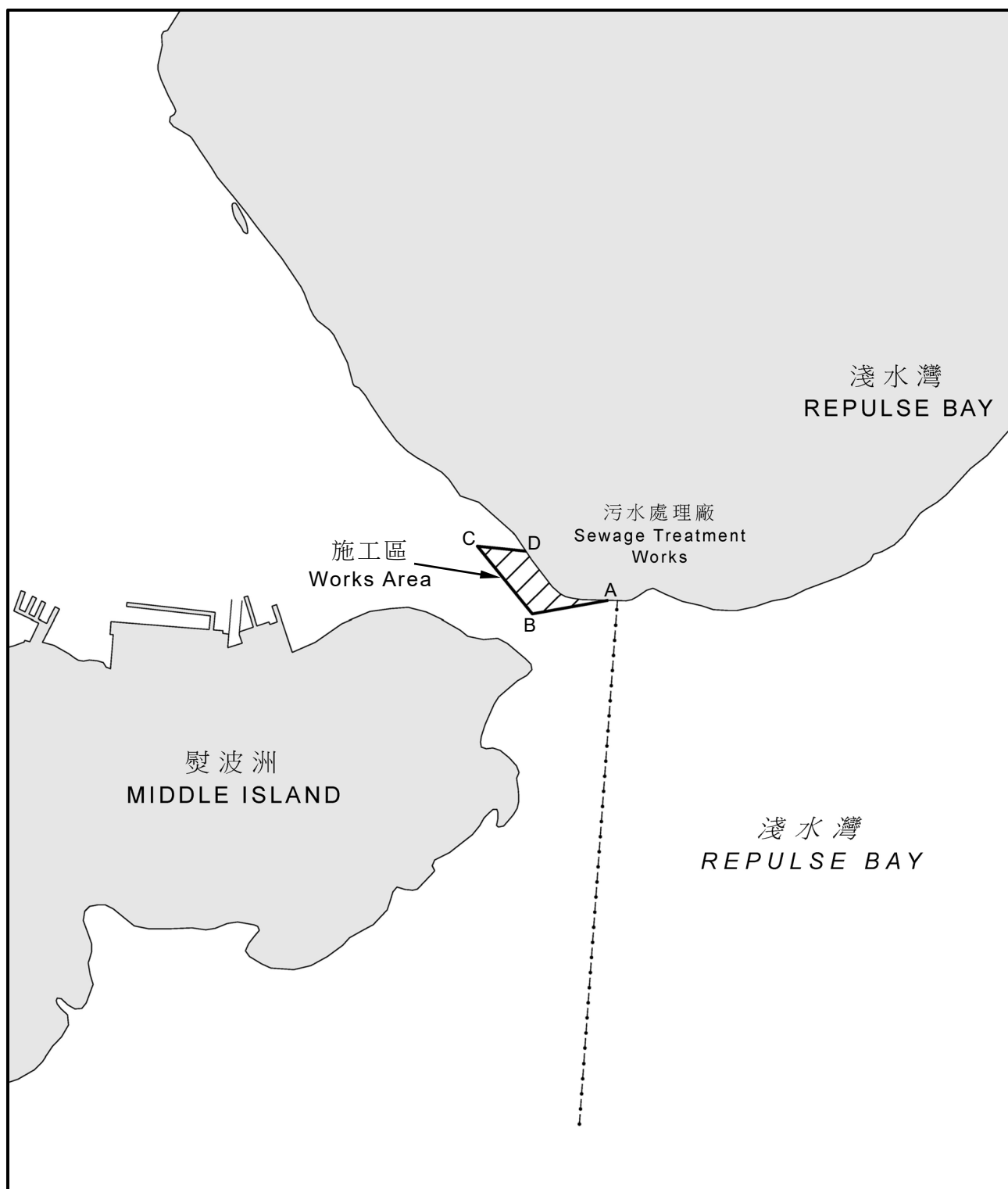
