Safe Handling of Cargo At Sea

The Chief Officer of a river trade vessel was hit by a container and

fell to the cargo hold bottom when he was trying to push the container lowering

into a slot. He was later certified dead in the hospital.

2. The investigation revealed that the Chief Officer was not aware of

the "dead spot" developed during cargo operation and stayed in the "dead spot"

without knowledge.

3. To avoid recurrence of similar accidents, the attention of owners,

masters and persons-in-charge of all vessels are drawn to the following

important advice: -

All persons involved in cargo operations must not stay in a

"dead spot" where there is no safe means of escape or the

means of escape is difficult to gain access to.
