The Berth Licence Agreements are for a period of 31 months tentatively from 1 January 2026 to 31 July 2028 for eight berths adjacent to the three Public Cargo Working Areas (PCWAs) as follows:—

Late tenders or submission by fax or electronic means, or tenders not deposited in the specified tender box will not be considered.

If tropical cyclone signal No. 8 or above is hoisted, or a black rainstorm warning signal or "extreme conditions" as announced by the Government is/are in force at any time between 9.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m. (Hong Kong Time) on 12 September 2025, the tender closing time will be postponed to 11.00 a.m. (Hong Kong Time) on the first working day (i.e. except Saturday, Sunday and public holiday) after the tropical cyclone signal No. 8 is lowered, or the black rainstorm warning signal or the 'extreme conditions' as announced by the Government ceased to be in force. In case of blockage of the public access to the location of the specified tender box at any time between 9.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m. (Hong Kong Time) on 12 September 2025, the Government will announce extension of the tender closing time until further notice. Following removal of the blockage, the Government will announce the extended tender closing time as soon as practicable. The above announcements will be made via press releases on the website of Information Services Department (http://www.info.gov.hk/gia/general/today.htm).

Tenderers must attach to each tender a bank draft in a sum equal to two times of the monthly fee it has quoted in the Form of Tender as a pledge of his good faith. The deposit will be returned to the unsuccessful tenderers without interest.
