Submission of Tender : Tenders must be clearly marked with the ‘Tender for Berth Licence Agreements of Berths adjacent to Chai Wan, Western District, Tuen Mun, Rambler Channel, Stonecutters Island and New Yau Ma Tei Public Cargo Working Areas (Tender Ref : PASTR2026-05)’ on the outside of the envelope (but the envelope shall not bear any indication of the identity of the Tenderer) addressed to the ‘Chairman, Marine Department Tender Committee’, and must be deposited in the Marine Department Tender Box situated at the Public Waiting Area on 3rd Floor (outside Central Marine Office, Room 308), Harbour Building, 38 Pier Road, Central, Hong Kong, before 11:00 a.m. (Hong Kong time) on 24 July 2026 (Friday). Later tenders or submission by fax or electronic means, or tenders not deposited in the specified tender box will not be considered.
