Details of Vacancy under Post-retirement Service Contract (PRSC) Scheme

Senior Inspector (Training) (Salary: HK\$ 79,920 to HK\$ 82,620 per month) [See Note]

Entry Requirements: Candidates should have met the following requirements -

- (a) Retired civil servants at the rank of Senior Ship Inspector or above who have ceased work in the Government for not more than three years at the time of close of application; or
- (b) Retired civil servants at the rank of Senior Ship Inspector or above who have been taking up comparable NCSC positions in the department in the recent three years; or
- (c) Retiring civil servants at the rank of Senior Ship Inspector or above who are on pre-retirement leave/ final leave, or will proceed on pre-retirement leave/ final leave within the next three months from the time of close of application; and
- (d) Must possess no less than ten years working experience in the field of naval architecture, including:
 - Ship design or structural construction or ship-repairing/ maintenance; and
 - Plan approval of newly-built or existing vessels including structural calculation and stability of vessel

Note: The salary to be offered will be determined by the Department after the selection process.

Duties: A Senior Inspector (Training) is mainly deployed for the following tasks -

- (a) To develop/deliver/evaluate training for the development of inspectorate staff;
- (b) To implement the Plan Approval Competency Scheme;
- (c) To implement the Survey Competency Scheme;
- (d) To serve as mentor in the Naval Architecture mentorship scheme;
- (e) To advise on upgrading and revisions on drawing approval standards and the work quality;
- (f) To assist in the review the CoPs for local vessels, to assist in the development and implementation of policies on strengthening the regulatory regime and to refine hull drawings and stability approval guidelines; and
- (g) To perform any other duties as assigned by supervisors.

Terms of Appointment: Successful candidate will be appointed on PRSC terms for 12 months.

Fringe Benefits: A gratuity may be granted upon satisfactory completion of the contract with consistently high standard of performance and conduct. **Such gratuity, plus any contribution made by the Government to a Mandatory Provident Fund (MPF) scheme in respect of the appointee as required by the MPF Schemes Ordinance, will equal to 15% of the total basic salary drawn during the contract period.** In addition to 14 days' annual leave, rest days, statutory holidays, paternity leave and sickness allowance, where appropriate, will be granted in accordance with the provisions of the Employment Ordinance.

Under the policy on prevention of double benefits, a civil servant who is re-appointed to the Government during his/her final leave period should not be allowed to receive two sets of fringe benefits for the overlapping period (except for the statutory MPF benefits). The appointee is therefore required to forgo his/her right to civil service pension benefits and all other civil service benefits during his/her final leave period of the civil service employment from the date of the appointment on PRSC terms to the end date of final leave period.
